

Cybersafety Use Agreement – Code of Conduct For Year 3-6 Students

We believe a good digital citizen:

- 1. Is a <u>confident</u>, <u>connected</u> and capable user of ICT's.
- 2. Will use ICT's for learning (life long learner).
- 3. Will think carefully about whether the information they see online is true.
- 4. Understands that they may experience difficulty when using ICT's (<u>perseverance</u>), but can deal with them.
- 5. Will always use ICT's to communicate with others in a positive way (excellence).
- 6. Will always be honest and fair (show equity) when using ICT's.
- 7. Will always respect people's privacy online.
- 8. Will help others become better digital citizens (actively involved).

Tapanui School agrees to:

- 1. Do its best to enhance learning through safe use of ICT's.
- 2. Work with students and their families to encourage and develop an understanding of the importance of cybersafety and digital citizenship.
- 3. Provide a 'google account' for each student to use. While access is 24/7, ownership of the account remains that of Tapanui School, therefore appropriate usage will be monitored whether usage is during school hours or at any other time..
- 4. Respond to any breaches in an appropriate manner. Breaches include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Searches or surfing of inappropriate material
 - b. Setting up subscriptions to third parties (eg. YouTube, Gaming sites etc)
 - c. Sharing inappropriate messages or images with others
 - d. Cyber-bullying, sexting, rude or obscene messages to others

Therefore I agree to:

- 1. Use ICT's appropriately at Tapanui School.
- 2. Take responsibility for my password and only logon using my username.
- 3. Report any rude or inappropriate use.
- 4. Respect all school equipment and report any damage, for which I may be responsible.
- 5. Only use the internet as directed by a teacher or supervising adult.
- 6. Avoid giving my personal information out online.
- 7. Use my school Google Account as if I was 'at school'.

I understand that if I break these rules, I may lose the privilege of using ICT's for a period of time and my parents may also be informed if the matter is serious.
